Isaiah 9:1 (ESV)- But there will be no gloom for her who was in anguish.

2. THE HOPE

Isaiah 9:3 (ESV)- The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone.

Isaiah 9:6 (ESV)-For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder

4. THE HELP

Isaiah 9:6-7 (ESV)-, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

5. THE HARMONY
