Jeremiah 33:14 (ESV)- Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will fulfill the promise I made to the house of Israel and the house of Judah.

## 2. THE PERSON

Jeremiah 33:15 (ESV)- In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch to spring up for David

## 3. THE PURPOSE

Jeremiah 33:15-16 (ESV)- ...and he shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. In those days Judah will be saved, and Jerusalem will dwell securely.

## 4. THE PEACE

Jeremiah 33:16 (ESV)- And this is the name by which it will be called: 'The Lord is our righteousness.
