1. LOVE PROVIDED

I John 4:7 (ESV)-Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.

2. LOVE INITIATED

I John 4:9 (ESV)-In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him.

3. LOVE DEMONSTRATED

I John 4:10 (ESV)-In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

4. LOVE PERFECTED

I John 4:11-12 (ESV)- Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.

I John 4:15 (ESV)- Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

B. Believe His Love

I John 4:16a (ESV)- So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us.

C. Return His Love

I John 4:16b (ESV)-God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

D. Demonstrate His Love

I John 4:21 (ESV)- And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother
