### 1. SAVING GRACE

Titus 2:11 (ESV)-For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people.

Ephesians 2:5 (ESV)-even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved

Ephesians 2:8-9 (ESV)-For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

“But we believe that we will be saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, just as they will.”

#### Why Saving Grace is needed.

Romans 3:23 (ESV)-for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 6:23 (ESV)- For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

#### What are we saved from?

John 3:36 (ESV)-Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

#### The Good News

Romans 1:16 (ESV)- For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

### 2. SUSTAINING GRACE

Romans 5:1-2 (ESV)-Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 12:8-9 (ESV)-Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Romans 11:6 (ESV)- But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (ESV)-For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

#### Why Sustaining Grace is needed.

Romans 7:19-20 (ESV)-For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing. Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me.

### 3. SANCTIFYING GRACE

Titus 2:11-12 (ESV)-For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age,

1 Peter 4:10-11 (ESV)-As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ.

### 4. SECURING GRACE

Jude 24-25 (ESV)- Now to him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy, to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.

Titus 3:7 (ESV)- so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
