# TRUTH 3: HONOR HIS NAME

<u>Study Verse Section:</u> You shall not take [Heb. לא תִשָּא lit. to raise up Qal Imperfect verb denoting a habitual action still in progress] the name of the LORD [Heb. אֶר־שֵׁם־יהוה YHWH–IAM] your God [Heb. אֶלֹהֶיךָ Elohim–plural name for God] in vain [Heb. לַשָּׁרְאַ lit. worthless or empty], for the LORD will not hold him guiltless [Heb. לָא יְנַקֶה lit. not leave unpunished] who takes his name in vain.
