Romans 3:23-24 (ESV)-for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

1. WHAT HAPPENED TO YOU?

Galatians 3:1 (ESV)- O foolish Galatians! <u>Who has bewitched you?</u> It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified.

The adversary wants to confuse the gospel.

2. HOW WERE YOU SAVED?

Galatians 3:2 (ESV)-Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?

We are saved by our <u>ears</u> not our <u>hands</u>.

3. HOW ARE YOU CHANGED?

Galatians 3:3 (ESV)-Are you so foolish? <u>Having begun by the Spirit,</u> are you now being perfected by the flesh?

We are changed daily and slowly.

4. WHY DID YOU SUFFER?

Galatians 3:4 (ESV)- <u>Did you suffer so many things in vain</u>—if indeed it was in vain?

Legalism confuses suffering, the gospel legitimizes suffering.

5. HAVE YOU FORGOT?

Galatians 3:5 (ESV)- Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and <u>works miracles among you do so by works of the law</u>, or by hearing with faith...?

The miraculous is not conditional on merit.

6. DO YOU SEE?

Galatians 3:6-9 (ESV)- ...just as <u>Abraham "believed God, and it was</u> <u>counted to him as righteousness"</u> Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, <u>preached the gospel beforehand to</u> <u>Abraham</u>, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." So then, <u>those who are of faith</u> are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

It has always been faith alone in Christ alone.

Here is The Point: There is sanctification in Christ alone!
