Genesis 39:9 (ESV)- But he refused and said to his master's wife, "....How then can I do this great wickedness and <u>sin against God</u>?"

5. HIS REMOVAL

Genesis 39:20 (ESV)- And Joseph's master took him and <u>put him into</u> the prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined...

Life Application Section

Genesis 39:1 (ESV)-Now Joseph had been brought down to Egypt, and Potiphar...an Egyptian, <u>had bought him...</u>

B. Be faithful where you are now.

Genesis 39:2 (ESV)-The Lord was with Joseph, and <u>he became a</u> <u>successful man and he was in the house of his Egyptian master.</u>

C. Do not be surprised at continuous temptation.

Genesis 39:10 (ESV)- And as <u>she spoke to Joseph day after day</u>, he would not listen to her, to lie beside her or to be with her

D. Live for an <u>audience</u> of <u>one</u>.

Genesis 39:9 (ESV)-"...How then can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?"
