The Disciples Had A

1. SUPERNATURAL EXPECTATION

Acts 2:1 (ESV)- When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.

We need a perspective change from hope to expectation.

2. SUPERNATURAL REALIZATION

Acts 2:2-4,43 (ESV)-And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance...And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.

We need a perspective change from natural to supernatural.

3. SUPERNATURAL DECLARATION

Acts 2:22-24 (ESV)- Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know— this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it.

We need a perspective change from familiarity to wonder.

4. SUPERNATURAL MULTIPLICATION

Acts 2:47 (ESV)-praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

Ephesians 2:4-5 (ESV)- But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved.

We need a perspective change from programs to prayer.
