1. THE REQUEST

Genesis 42:2 (ESV)- And he said, “Behold, I have heard that there is grain for sale in Egypt. Go down and buy grain for us there, that we may live and not die.

2. THE RELUCTANCE

Genesis 42:3-4 (ESV)- So ten of Joseph's brothers went down to buy grain in Egypt. But Jacob did not send Benjamin, Joseph's brother, with his brothers, for he feared that harm might happen to him.

3. THE RECOGNITION

Genesis 42:8 (ESV)- And Joseph recognized his brothers, but they did not recognize him.

4. THE REVEALING

Genesis 42:14 (ESV)- By this you shall be tested: by the life of Pharaoh, you shall not go from this place unless your youngest brother comes here...

5. THE REALIZATION

Genesis 42:21 (ESV)- Then they said to one another, “In truth we are guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the distress of his soul, when he begged us and we did not listen.

Genesis 42:21 (ESV)- “...That is why this distress has come upon us.”

Genesis 42:25 (ESV)- And Joseph gave orders to fill their bags with grain, and to replace every man's money in his sack, and to give them provisions for the journey. This was done for them.
