1. THE EXHORTATION

Galatians 6:7 (ESV)-Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap.

The deception is that actions don't matter!

We mock God with our legalism and license.

2. THE EXAMINATION

Galatians 6:8 (ESV)-For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

We are sowing daily!

Our schedule and spending are evidence of our sowing.

3. THE EXPLANATION

Galatians 6:8 (ESV)-For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Whatever we sow is going to grow!

John 17:3 (ESV)-And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.
