James 1:2-3 (ESV) <u>Count it all joy</u>, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds for you know that <u>the testing of your faith produces</u> <u>steadfastness</u>

C. Let it work.

James 1:4 (ESV)- And <u>let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect</u> and complete, lacking in nothing.

James 1:5 (ESV)- If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him
