HISTORICAL CONTEXT

- + Jesus came into Jerusalem as King.
- + He cleanses the temple a second time.
- + He teaches and heals in the temple.
- + He is anointed for burial at a dinner.

1. THE RITUAL

Luke 22:7-8 (ESV)-Then came the <u>day of Unleavened Bread, on</u> <u>which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed</u>. So Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, "Go and prepare the Passover for us, that we may eat it."

2. THE REVELATION

Luke 22:19-20 (ESV)- he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "<u>This is my body, which is given for you</u>...And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is <u>the new covenant in my blood</u>.

3. THE REQUEST

Luke 22:25-26 (ESV)- And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Life Application Section

The last supper invites us to...

A. Look forward

Luke 22:18 (ESV)- For I tell you that from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."

B. Look backward

Luke 22:19 (ESV)- And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

C. Look upward

Luke 22:20 (ESV)-And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is <u>the new covenant in my blood</u>.

D. Look inward

I Corinthians 11:28 (ESV)-<u>Let a person examine himself</u>, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup.
