- ♦ He spends the entire night in trials and torture.
- → Jesus spends 6 hours on the cross (9am-3pm).
- → He is then placed in a tomb with guards outside.
- ◆ The ladies have their encounter with angels & Jesus.

# 1. THE DISCUSSION

Luke 24:13-14 (ESV)-That very day two of them were going to a village named Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and they were talking with each other about all these things that had happened."

# 2. THE DISCOURAGEMENT

Luke 24:20 (ESV)-and how our chief priests and rulers delivered him up to be condemned to death, and crucified him. But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel.

# 3. THE DECLARATION

Luke 24:25-26 (ESV)- And he said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?"

# 4. THE DISPLAY

Luke 24:30-31 (ESV)-When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed and broke it and gave it to them. And their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. And he vanished from their sight.

# A. Our hopelessness

Luke 24:21(ESV)- <u>But we had hoped</u> that he was the one to redeem Israel...it is now the third day since these things happened.

## B. Our fear

Luke 24:33 (ESV)- And they rose that same hour <u>and returned to Jerusalem.</u> And they found the eleven...

# C. Our doubt

Luke 24:34 (ESV)- saying, "The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!

#### D. Our Lives

Luke 24:52-53 (ESV)- And they worshiped him... and were continually in the temple blessing God.
