1. THE MEDIUM

2 Corinthians 4:7 (ESV)- But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us.

2. THE MOLDING

A. The Purpose

2 Corinthians 4:18 (ESV)- as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.
