3. THE <u>REBUTTAL</u>

Luke 11:31 (ESV)-<u>The queen of the South will rise up at the judgment</u> with the men of this generation and condemn them, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.

4. THE <u>REVEAL</u>

Matthew 12:41b (ESV)- ... for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and behold, <u>something greater than Jonah is here</u>.

Luke 11:31b(ESV)- ...and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.
