1. THE PERSUASION

2 Corinthians 5:11,14-15 (ESV)- Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade others...For the love of Christ controls us.. that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him.

2. THE PROCESS

2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away, behold, the new has come.

3. THE PROMISE

2 Corinthians 5:18-19 (ESV)- All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself,

4. THE PURPOSE

2 Corinthians 5:20-21 (ESV)-Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

To make disciples effectively we must...

A. See <u>people</u> differently

2 Corinthians 5:16 (ESV)- From now on, therefore, we regard no one according to the flesh.

B. See <u>ourselves</u> differently

2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV)- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away, behold, the new has come.

C. See <u>purpose</u> differently

2 Corinthians 5:20 (ESV)- Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us.

D. See method differently

2 Corinthians 6:1(ESV)- Working together with him, then, we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain.
