1. THE STATEMENT

Romans 6:14 (ESV)- For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

2. THE QUESTION

Romans 6:15 (ESV)-What then? Are we to sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means!

3. THE REASON

Romans 6:16 (ESV)- Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness?

4. THE COMPARISON

Romans 6:20-21 (ESV)- For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. But what fruit were you getting at that time from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death.

5. THE ENCOURAGEMENT

Romans 6:22 (ESV)- But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the fruit you get leads to sanctification and its end, eternal life.

Life Application Section

A. Keep fighting.

Romans 6:12 (ESV)- Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions.

B. Keep obeying.

Romans 6:17 (ESV)- But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed

C. Keep growing.

Romans 6:22 (ESV)- But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the fruit you get leads to sanctification and its end, eternal life.
