Audience: South Galatia Churches (Derbe, Lystra, Iconium, and Pisidian Antioch.)

Key Verse: Galatians 5:1 (ESV)-For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.



1. THE TESTIMONY OF FREEDOM

Galatians 1:1-2 (ESV)- Paul, an apostle—not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead— and all the brothers who are with me,

Romans 5:10 (ESV)-For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.
