



Paul's Explanation

1. THE CLARIFICATION

Galatians 2:15-16 (ESV)- We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ,

Justification happens in a moment, sanctification happens daily.

2. THE REALIZATION

Galatians 2:16-17 (ESV)- yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified. But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we too were found to be sinners, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not!

The law reveals, it does not fix.

3. THE TEMPTATION

Galatians 2:18-19 (ESV)- For if I rebuild what I tore down, I prove myself to be a transgressor. For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live to God.

To forget that Jesus has freed freely and forever.

4. THE TRANSFORMATION

Galatians 2:20 (ESV)- I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

In God's eyes my sins are no longer mine.

5. THE NULLIFICATION

Galatians 2:21 (ESV)- I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.

Rather than nullify grace, let us rest in it.

Here Is The Point: There is justification in Christ alone!
