Galatians 5:1 (ESV)-For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

Romans 3:23-24 (ESV)-for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

Paul's Explanation

1. THE CLARIFICATION

Galatians 2:15-16 (ESV)- We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; yet we know that a person is <u>not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ</u>,

Justification happens in a moment, sanctification happens daily.

2. THE REALIZATION

Galatians 2:16-17 (ESV)- yet we know that a person is <u>not justified by works of the law</u> but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, <u>because by works of the law no one will be justified.</u> But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, <u>we too were found to be sinners</u>, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not!

The law <u>reveals</u>, it does not <u>fix</u>.

3. THE TEMPTATION

Galatians 2:18-19 (ESV)- For <u>if I rebuild what I tore down</u>, I prove myself to be a transgressor. For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live to God.

To forget that Jesus has freed freely and forever.

4. THE TRANSFORMATION

Galatians 2:20 (ESV)- I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

In God's eyes my sins are no longer mine.

5. THE NULLIFICATION

Galatians 2:21 (ESV)- <u>I do not nullify the grace of God</u>, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.

Rather than nullify grace, let us rest in it.

Here is The Point: There is justification in Christ alone!
