Genesis 41:1, 5 (ESV)-Pharaoh dreamed that he was standing by the Nile...And he fell asleep and dreamed a second time...

Genesis 41:8 (ESV) So in the morning his spirit was troubled, and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt and all its wise men...

Genesis 41:9-12 (ESV)- Then the chief cupbearer said to Pharaoh, “I remember... A young Hebrew... he interpreted our dreams...”
