1. AT THE TABLE THERE IS <u>ACCEPTANCE</u> Psalm 23:5 (ESV)-<u>You prepare a table before me</u> in the presence of my enemies;

I John 3:1a. (ESV)-See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are.

2. AT THE TABLE THERE IS REFRESHMENT

Psalm 23:5 (ESV)-You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows

Psalm 23:5 (MSG)-You serve me a six-course dinner right in front of my enemies. You revive my drooping head; my cup brims with blessing.

Jeremiah 31:25 (NIV84)-"I will refresh the weary and satisfy the faint."

3. AT THE TABLE THERE IS RELATIONSHIP

Psalm 23:5 (ESV)-I You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Zephaniah 3:17 (ESV)-The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; <u>he will rejoice over you with gladness</u>; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.

Psalm 147:11 (ESV)- but <u>the Lord takes pleasure</u> in those who fear him, in those who hope in his steadfast love.
