John 15:3 (ESV)- Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you.

- ◆ The word appears 134 times in scripture.

1. HIS CHARACTER

Psalm 86:5-For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you.

Micah 7:18 (ESV)-Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance?

2. HIS PURPOSE

Isaiah 43:25 (ESV)-I, I am he who blots out your transgressions for my own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

1 John 2:12 (ESV)-I am writing to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven for his name's sake.

3. HIS FORGIVENESS

Psalm 103:12 (ESV)-as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

Micah 7:19 (ESV)-He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

Hebrews 8:12 (ESV)-For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.

4. HIS EXPECTATION

Colossians 3:13 (ESV)-bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

Luke 17:3 (ESV)-Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him
